2019 SEASONAL AGREEMENT

THE 2019 SEASONAL AGREEMENT SUPERSEDES ALL OTHER AGREEMENTS
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE ASKING ANY QUESTIONS OF THE PLAYFUL GOOSE

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VACATIONAL RATE: is not for continuous occupancy or more than 3 days per individual week. **FULL TIME RATE** is for more than 3 days per week and for everyday use. If a seasonal has had a record of being Full Time, then payment for Full Time will be expected in March. If seasonal does not exceed Vacational Rate, then a refund for the difference of rate will be issued at end of season.

1. **SEASONAL RATES + DURATION:** Our Season starts April 24th and ends Sept. 30th. **INCLUDES TAX**

"Vacational" (does not exceed 3 days/wk. plus 2 wk. vacation or 83 days.)

WEEKLYS & MONTHLYS (1 week or more)

A minimum stay of 7 consecutive days will require a signature of this agreement. Weekly and monthly campsite renters are under the same rules and regulations as our seasonal campers. Clean-up deposits will be required. Deposits will be returned after you have departed the site and the site has been reviewed. See # 5 (DEPOSITS).

PAYMENT + REQUIREMENTS ARE DUE MARCH 31ST, 2019

If full payment is not received prior to April 1st, a charge of \$10.00/wk. or 1½% interest on balance per month, whichever is greater, will be assessed as a "late fee".

**Seasonals not fully paid by the start of the season will be rated as a Monthly, with no option for the seasonal discount. Late fees after March 31st will apply. This does not apply to 1st year Seasonals.

* **NEW SEASONALS:** All Seasonals starting anytime in May will pay Full Seasonal Rate. Those starting June 1st or later in the season will be pro-rated (12-week min. charge). This is due by the start of camping.

2. **REQUIREMENTS:**

- A. **COPY OF YOUR "CAMPING UNIT'S TITLE"**
- B. **"UP TO DATE" PROOF OF INSURANCE ON YOUR CAMPER + GOLF CART + BOAT. IF YOUR INSURANCE COMES DUE DURING SEASON, PLEASE UPDATE US WITH YOUR RENEWAL.**
- C. **PAYMENT + ALL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2019 SEASON ARE DUE IN MARCH or before. IF RECEIVED AFTER MARCH 31ST, THERE IS A \$10.00 LATE FEE CHARGE EACH WEEK OR 1 ½% INTEREST ON THE REMAINING BALANCE PER MONTH, which-ever is greater.**
- D. **ELECTRICAL METER PAYMENTS ARE DUE BY JULY 15TH AND BEFORE YOU LEAVE AT THE END OF THE SEASON, ALONG WITH THE WINTER STORAGE PAYMENT. LATE FEE OF \$10.00 PER WEEK OR 1 ½% PER MONTH ON REMAINING BALANCE, which-ever is greater, WILL BE CHARGED.**

3. SUBLETTING OF SITES IS NOT ALLOWED:

If you sell your unit, the campsite is not part of the transaction. Ask us if it has already been reserved.

Refund or Pro-rating of payment, for early departure, is not allowed.

We reserve the right to deny site rental to anyone at any time.

If you leave by your own volition or by management request or any reason whatsoever, there will be no refund.

4. STORAGE RATE: October 1, 2019 to April 24, 2020 will be \$240. Tax included, subject to change.

STORAGE AREA: The charge is \$35.00/ month or \$10.00/ week for each Travel Trailer/Motor Home/ 5th Wheel. Boats and Pop-ups are charged by size. Example: A small boat on a trailer occupying 12'x4' will be charged ½ the price of a 28'x8' Travel Trailer. We need a copy of your Title for the item in storage along with a signed agreement. **BEFORE ENTERING STORAGE AREA, please notify the office for permission.**

Storage of a 2nd unit on site is not allowed. Boats and extra camping units, stored on the campground, will be charged at prevailing rates, prepaid. Off-Season access to Camping or Stored Units might require at least a weeks' notice. We may not be available; the entrance hill might be icy or impassable.

5. SITE DEPOSITS:

A "ONE TIME" DEPOSIT OF \$100.00 will be required to hold your site for the following year. The deposit does not go towards the sites' rental. It will be returned to you, provided you let us know between the time period of April 24 to Sept. 30 and all outstanding bills have been paid.

CLEAN-UP DEPOSITS:

Every site occupied for 1 week or longer will require a Clean-up Deposit of \$100. This is to cover any damage done to the grass and ground during your stay. In addition, WE REQUIRE A DEPOSIT OF \$100.00 FOR EACH SHED, DOUBLE DECKS (WIDER THAN 8'), SCREEN ROOMS, AND ANY OTHER STRUCTURE PLACED ON YOUR RENTED SITE. For weekly and monthly campers this includes dead patches of grass due to outdoor rugs not being moved around. (THESE DEPOSITS WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN YOUR SITE IS IN A CLEANED-UP, ABUNDANT GRASS GROWING, READY-TO-RENT CONDITION!) IF YOU LEAVE WITHOUT RETURNING YOUR SITE TO THE CONDITIONS LISTED BELOW, THERE WILL BE A CHARGE OF \$50.00 PER HOUR PER PERSON FOR OUR EFFORTS TO CLEAN UP THE SITE. **Bare ground needs to be cleaned of nails, screws, rocks, etc. Next, holes need to be filled, loosen hard soil by raking or adding soil, then sodded or seeded. The seed needs to be covered by soil or they won't germinate, also the birds will see and eat the seeds. Then, watered and covered with burlap or similar type fabric, (Do not use Straw). It is suggested that you do this prior to leaving.) Adequate grass must be growing before deposit can be returned. (The Fire Pit needs to be cleaned of ashes and rocks. Cold ashes are to be deposited in the garbage dumpster along with nails, screws, glass, etc. from inside and around the fire pit. Ask us where to place the rocks, as the location changes. The lawn needs to be cut, holes filled, and grass raked smooth. Ask Randy if you have any questions.**

6. DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS:

Bills must be paid up, along with all the Requirements by the end of MARCH. Otherwise, camping on site will not be permitted and electric box will be locked.

Delinquent accounts will not be permitted to hold a seasonal site. The site will be forfeited. We reserve the right to move your unit and possessions off site. Labor charges of \$50.00 per hour will be applied to bill.

Possessions (camping unit, deck, shed, screen house etc.) must be removed by April 1st unless weather prohibits it. The unit can be placed in our storage area at the prevailing rates, pre-paid, but boats, cars, sheds decks etc. will be individually charged. The site must be left clean & presentable for the next renter. See #5 "SITE DEPOSIT" & CLEAN UP. Overdue bills are subject to a \$10.00 charge on total bill per week or 1 ½% interest per month, which-ever is greater. If no attempt is made to pay your bill after a reasonable amount of time, legal action will start and the things you left behind will be sold and/or given away.

Anything put into the ground automatically BECOMES THE PROPERTY of the Playful Goose Campground, which includes trees, posts, poles, flowers, plants, etc., and will be determined by the Campground Management.

7. ELECTRICITY:

Seasonal sites are metered. Bring in first payment for electricity by the 15TH OF JULY + YOUR LAST PAYMENT BEFORE YOU LEAVE, OR BY END OF THE SEASON, SEPT. 30TH. Overdue electric bills will be charged \$5.00/week for 4 weeks, then \$10.00/week thereafter.

Minimum seasonal electric charge is \$25.00. NOTE: If your electric meter stops working, tell us as soon as possible or we will pro-rate the reading from previous months or last year.

DO NOT ATTACH ANYTHING TO OR COVER OUR WOODEN 4x4 WATER & ELECTRIC POSTS! DO NOT INSTALL WIRES IN THE GROUND OR OPEN-UP OUR ELECTRICAL BOXES. Tampering with or installing any electric wires, meters, duplexes, circuit breakers, etc. to our electrical service will be cause for REMOVAL from the campground and without any refunds!

8. TAKING UNIT OUT TEMPORARILY:

All bills must be paid before leaving. Notify office of departure and when you expect to return.

VACATED CAMPSITES: Property of any kind left (including firewood) on unoccupied sites is the property of the Campground. Anyone caught removing property is cause for ejection from campground.

9. WATER + ELECTRIC POSTS:

Do not attach anything to these posts! Such as garden hoses, hangers, clothes lines etc. Thank you. You may install a 2nd post for your own use, but 1st check with the office for a safe location; to prevent bodily harm and damage to buried water + electric lines.

If you notice that the water faucet is leaking, please let us know first, so we can repair the problem. Otherwise, the wooden post may tend to rot. (DO NOT TIGHTEN OR LOOSEN THE BACKFLOW PREVENTER because this will not fix the problem but will damage the faucet!) If there is damage, you will be charged for parts & labor.

10. FOR SALE SIGNS & COMMISSION:

You may post signs, but none that are offensive, sexual, or degrading. Signs need to be approved by the office before posting for language and location. Before putting any sign posts into the ground please ask office first to avoid hitting any electrical wires or water lines as these run in multiple directions.

SALE OF YOUR UNIT: If we sell your unit, the commission per sale is 5% or \$100, whichever is greater.

11. GUESTS:

When is a guest not a guest, but an additional person? When the guest exceeds 1 overnight visit per week or for two consecutive weeks. If a guest uses a site more than authorized, the renter would be responsible to list the guest as an additional adult and is subject to the corresponding fees. If an adult sets up a tent on a seasonal site the charge would be ½ price a regular tent site rental.

Guests of Seasonals are free between 9am-7pm. No guests are allowed to enter before or after these hours, to ensure the safety of our campers and property. Guests must register at office upon entering the grounds and at minimum purchase a \$2 car pass per vehicle, 100% refundable within the hour. Car passes are charged per car, not per person. Parking is only allowed in the designated parking lots located throughout the campground, NOT on an empty site, on the grass, or in the road. Guests must notify the office at check-in or re-register before 7pm if they would like to stay overnight. Guests staying in the Seasonal's unit are free of charge. If your guests are 18 yrs. old or older and set up a tent, have any camping unit, sleep in a car, etc. then the prevailing daily camping charges apply. **YOU MUST INFORM YOUR GUESTS to register upon arrival and ensure they park in the correct parking areas. They should be made aware of the rules from you!** Seasonals will ultimately be responsible for their guests' actions and any damage they cause or create.

Visitors of any age are not allowed to drive golf carts on Playful Goose Property, no exceptions! See #17 "Golf carts" for more information.

12. CHILDREN & CURFEW:

Children (Under 21 yrs. Old) are not allowed on the campground without their parent's supervision. You are responsible for their actions and any damages they cause or create.

Children should be on their assigned site by dark, if not using bathroom, game room, or swimming pool. For their safety and the security of others do not allow them to wander throughout the campground after dark. Please avoid loud noises, boomboxes are not allowed. Quiet time is from 9pm to 9am. The playground is closed after dark.

13. CAMPFIRE ASHES, BRUSH AND TREES:

DO NOT BURN PLASTIC ITEMS!!! BURNING PLASTIC IS POISONOUS AND HARMFUL TO BREATHE IN. It smells obnoxious when eating and causes difficulty breathing for those with respiratory and allergy problems. **COLD** ashes should be deposited in the dumpster only! Campfires are allowed under close supervision only. Don't leave your fires unattended. Brush can now be deposited behind the blue toilet stalls (port-a-potties) near the river.

TREES:

Do not cut or break (Vandalize) dead or live limbs from trees or bushes, let us know and we will do what is necessary. Do not install nails or screw etc. in trees. Besides harming the tree, future chainsaw cutting could hit one of these metal pieces and break the chain, cutting one's face, neck, and arms. Please loop a rope around limbs or trunks to avoid damage to trees. Anything planted in the ground will become the property of the Playful Goose, ask us. The fruit of our apple trees & other fruit bearing plants are not to be picked in volume or stripped, but you can take what will fit in your hand. Any more than this will be considered theft. Ask the office if you want a large volume for pie or juice, as we can agree on a price.

14. GRASS CUTTING:

Seasonals are required to cut and trim their own grass. If you cannot make it up to cut, there is an outside service that will mow your lawn for a fee. Ask in office. PLEASE NOTIFY US IF YOU CANNOT MAKE IT FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD, for whatever reason so we can decide the best option for you. If you collect grass clippings, they can be disposed of the same as with brush, behind the port-a-potties (see #13). Do not place in high grass or near trees. **THERE IS A \$25.00 FINE APPLIED TO YOUR BILL, FOR EACH WEEK GRASS IS OVER 5" LONG.**

15. GARBAGE:

Place garbage in tied plastic bags into the dumpster across from the office.

Acceptable garbage: **ONLY FOOD RELATED ITEMS AND COLD FIRE PIT ASHES!** (glass, cans, plastic bottles, animal feces (in tied plastic bags), milk containers, and cold ashes).

***NOT ALLOWED*:** Lawn chairs, furniture, blankets, pillows, sleeping bags, metal parts, florescent lights, cardboard, bikes, tires, batteries, appliances, screen tents, SPRING OR FALL CLEANING of your trailer or shed items, etc...these are not considered campground garbage! Please help keep the campground clean for all to enjoy ☺.

TO KEEP THE SEASONAL RATES DOWN, PLEASE DO NOT DEPOSIT PROHIBITED ITEMS FROM YOUR SITE INTO THE DUMPSTER. PLEASE TAKE IT HOME OR TO THE HORICON DUMP. THANK YOU!

There is a garbage dump East of Horicon. Take Hwy. 33 East to County. Trunk V, make a left, and it is down 1.2 miles on the right or take it home with you.

16. VANDALISM & THEFT:

Anyone caught, will result in immediate cancellation of their stay here, no refunds. Pack up and leave. If you witness anything or experience such please notify the office as soon as possible. Additional reference to #13 (TREES).

17. GOLF CARTS:

4wheel drive carts/ATVs are not allowed on campground.

Who: Only registered Seasonals over 21 years old **ON YOUR SIGNED AGREEMENTS** are allowed to drive golf carts. We do not allow guests to drive carts. Children are not allowed to drive golf carts on campground property, INCLUDING SITTING ON YOUR LAP!

Requirements: PUT YOUR SITE #'S ON THE LEFT OR RIGHT REAR FENDER IN 4" SIZE OR LARGER. SITE NUMBER MUST BE VISIBLE, DO NOT PLACE ANYTHING INABLING ITS VISIBILITY WHILE DRIVING. SPEED LIMIT IS 5 - 7 MPH. AS POSTED! ONLY ONE CART PER SITE IS ALLOWED. HOURS OF GOLF CART OPERATION: 8AM TO 10PM. Any golf cart not on their own site outside of these hours will be subject to losing golf cart privileges.

Where: Golf carts must only be driven on gravel roads, or on a camper's site, **ONLY** if invited to do so. The few exceptions such as around the main building, playgrounds, etc., have been posted in the office. Please review this prior to driving your golf cart! **TRAILS: GOLF CARTS ARE ONLY ALLOWED ON THE SOUTHERN MARKED "RIDGE TRAIL" AND THE FIRST PART OF "SHADY TRAIL".**

Golf carts have done \$3,000.00 damage to the farmer's field 3 years ago. Fines and loss of golf cart use will be imposed to anyone found driving where they don't belong! **OBEY SIGNS AND KEEP ON THE AUTHORIZED CART TRAILS. VIOLATORS WILL LOSE THE PRIVILEGE TO USE ANY GOLF CART ON THE PROPERTY AND MUST TAKE IT OFF PLAYFUL GOOSE PROPERTY!**

18. SWIMMING POOL:

The Pool Season starts from Friday, May 24th @ 5 PM (Memorial Day Weekend) and every day until Monday, September 2nd @ 5 PM (Labor Day weekend), then 'weekends only' till closing on Monday, September 30th. There are no Life Guards on duty. You are responsible for your own actions. Parents are responsible for their children's actions and for any damage they cause.

THE SLIDE: MUST BE USED IN A SEATED FORWARD POSITION AT ALL TIMES!

STATE LAW: NO FOOD OR DRINK OR SMOKING IN THE POOL AREA!

Do not use safety rope for standing on (it will stretch + becomes useless to a novice swimmer who may need it to stay afloat). It is positioned before a drop off point. **ANY TAMPERING WITH POOL FACILITIES INCLUDING CHAIRS, TABLES, SLIDE, RESTROOMS, ETC. WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF POOL USE AND POSSIBLE FINES FOR DAMAGES.**

19. BOATS & UTILITY TRAILERS :

ALL UTILITY TRAILERS NEED TO BE INSPECTED IN FRONT OF OFFICE BY MANAGEMENT BEFORE PROCEEDING. PLEASE, NOTIFY OFFICE when parking it across from office so we know who to contact if anything happens to it or if it needs to be moved.

BOATS AND/OR UTILITY TRAILERS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON CAMPSITES!--A \$10.00 A DAY FINE WILL BE IMPOSED FOR EACH DAY OF OCCURRENCE. THEY ARE ALLOWED TO BE STORED ACROSS FROM OFFICE UP TO BUT NOT ON THE GRASS FOR WEEKENDS + VACATION AT NO CHARGE, BUT NOT DURING THE WEEK IF NOT ON VACATION HERE. REGISTER YOUR BOAT, SITE #, NAME, ETC. IN OFFICE. OTHERWISE, TAKE THEM HOME WHEN YOUR WEEKEND STAY IS OVER, OR YOU WILL BE CHARGED FOR STORAGE. Boats can be stored in our storage area, at the prevailing rates, if desired. Notify the office before entering the storage area, by phone or in person.

20. WINTERIZING:

Be sure you have a water heater bypass. Winterizing begins approximately 10/5 of each year. Starting at \$60.00, variations in charges include: Recirculating or Float type toilets, outside showers, ice makers, etc. There is a \$5.00 charge for each variation. **DO NOT DRAIN YOUR WATER HEATER.** If you drain your city water system, there will be

a \$20.00 charge. We assume you do not have water in your fresh water tank. If you don't have a water heater bypass, there is an additional charge of \$25.00. So, check prior to signing up or ask if unsure.

21. PARKING VEHICLES:

ALL VEHICLES REQUIRE A CAR PASS FROM THE OFFICE UPON ARRIVAL INTO THE CAMPGROUND! Park on the gravel pads provided for your site, don't double park next to pad (unless you have a double-wide pad), on an empty site pad, in the road, or on the grass. Extra vehicles can be parked at the various parking lots. First offense will be fined \$5 plus car pass fee when found without pass! For guest passes, please see #12 (GUESTS). For those who have guests requiring special assistance to sites, please pick them up from the parking lot with your golf cart or park your vehicle in the parking lot to allow your guests to park at your site. This will not be a permitted excuse for violating rules.

22. APPLIANCES and ELECTRIC USE:

Refrigerators and other large appliances must be stored in your shed or trailer out of view. *Please take into consideration the amperage supplied to your site. DO NOT TAP MORE ELECTRIC FROM YOUR ELECTRICAL POST THAN WAS ISSUED. A 30AMP SITE IS ONLY TO DRAW 30 AMP...A 50AMP, JUST 50AMP, NOT THE ADDITIONAL 30 AMP AND (2) 20 AMP OUTLETS SOMETIMES AVAILABLE. THESE ARE OPTIONAL OUTLETS ONLY! Some of you have been burning the outlets, breakers, and wires.* You may want to find out how much amperage each appliance uses and remember each trailer has a converter that continuously runs several amps alone. Please, ask us if you are unsure.

23. PROPANE:

Tanks are filled by weight, not by volume. (Removable Tanks) FILL TIMES are 10a.m. or 2pm. or 6pm. Pay at least 15 minutes before fill times in office. You will be given a ticket with adhesive tape to apply to tank. Then, you take your tank to the propane platform. Everyone should check their tanks for gas leaks with a soap/water solution. Parts are available in office.

24. SUBCONTRACTORS:

No deliveries of any kind are permitted to enter campground without us having prior knowledge, including supplies ordered from outside. YOU MUST BE PRESENT WHEN DELIVERIES ARE MADE. You are responsible for damages caused by services you invited into the campground. You must inform them to register upon entering and to receive a car pass to confirm their registration and that they are aware of the campground driving rules. No digging holes or pouring of cement! Use cement blocks on top of ground (scraping the ground as a level base for a concrete block is allowed.) If your subcontractor makes such requests, inform them of our rules or send them to the office. All deliveries will be required to register upon arrival for a \$2 car pass, 100% refundable within the hour of arrival.

25. PETS:

PETS MUST BE QUIET, CLEANED-UP AFTER, AND NEVER LEFT ALONE TO BARK! If you leave your site, your pets should be with you and not left inside the camper or outside to bark, disturbing neighbors or people passing on the road. When you are on site, the pets should be placed either outside your camper on a leash or be inside your trailer. We get complaints from many people about animals running up to them which can be quite frightening. Be respectful and clean-up after your pet, whether at your site or walking around the campground. Dispose of doggy bags in dumpster or your own trash, no in the port-a-potties!

26. FIREWOOD:

NO FIREWOOD DELIVERIES! This also includes pallets, boards, 2X cutoffs, or any other wood, and if you have any of these left here please take it off the campground this April! ALL UTILITY TRAILERS NEED TO BE INSPECTED IN FRONT OF OFFICE BY MANAGEMENT BEFORE DRIVING THROUGH THE CAMPGROUND.

Due to the Ash Borer killing trees closer each year, WE ARE NO LONGER ALLOWING FIREWOOD TO BE BROUGHT INTO THE CAMPGROUND! Only firewood from the Playful Goose Campground will be allowed on the property. Chainsaws are not allowed on the campground. See Randy if you want to hand saw a limb or need some help with trimming trees.

27. BUILDING STRUCTURES:

Inform the Campground of any structure you are thinking of building or buying for your site. No digging holes or pouring of cement! Use cement blocks on top of ground (scraping the ground as a level base for a concrete block is allowed.) Each shed or structure requires a minimum of \$100.00 deposit, depending on size. There is a restriction on shed sizes determined by site and materials used. SEE RANDY BEFORE YOU START CONSTRUCTION.

Maximum allowed shed dimensions: Wood shed: 6'X8', Metal: 8'X10', Plastic: Any size. Double decks wider than 8' will require additional deposits. Refer to #5 (CLEAN-UP DEPOSITS) for additional information.

28. NOISE:

USE OF FIREWORKS WITH NOISE OR ANY PROJECTILE THAT HAS THE POSSIBILITY TO LAND ON AWNINGS, TENTS, TRAILERS, PEOPLE, ETC. IS NOT ALLOWED ON THE CAMPGROUND. QUIET TIME IS FROM 9PM TO 9AM. Repeatedly loud profanity and discriminatory remarks are prohibited and will be handled accordingly.

29. CAR PASSES:

Up to two "Seasonal Car Passes" can be picked up by each seasonal site at no charge in office upon first arrival at no charge. Additional car passes can be purchased in the office. Cars must be parked on your site or in parking lots! No parking on empty sites, on grass, or in the road!

Each car entering the campground will require a car pass. This includes your guests, visitors, daily, weekend, and monthly campers. There are "seasonal", "monthly", and "daily" car passes available (rates below). Each site will be evaluated to determine how many cars can be parked on your site, ask if you are unsure. All deliveries will be required to register upon arrival, for campground instructions and safety. Refer to #24 (SUBCONTRACTORS). \$2 (refundable) hourly and daily passes are also available to all visitors.

Car passes are charged per car, not per person. Rates are for consecutive days and subject to change: 1-DAY \$2, 2-DAY \$3, WEEKLY (up to 7 consecutive days) \$5, MONTHLY (up to 30 consecutive days) \$10, SEASONAL \$20. Those found without passes will be charged (min.) \$5 plus the car pass fee for first time offenses. The seasonal car pass does not provide anyone the freedom to park unlimited cars on your site. After authorized parking capacity of your site has been reached, additional cars must be driven to our designated parking lots located throughout the campground. Double-wide pads can also be built upon request. If your guests cannot walk long distances, please pick up your guests with your golf carts and take them to your site or let them take your spot and park your vehicle in the lot. This is not a valid reason to exceed your site's parking capacity.

30. 2019 CHANGES:

Seasonals not fully paid by the start of the season will be rated as a Monthly. Late fees after March 31st will apply. This does not apply to 1st year Seasonals.

ALL RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE BY MANAGEMENT.

MEMO for 2019:

- **STOP IN the office for your car passes upon your 1st arrival of the 2019 season. Remember that each vehicle in the campground at one time must have a car pass visibly displayed from the road.** Your site's 2019 car pass can be swapped for multiple cars but can only cover one at a time. Additional passes must be purchased at the office. **All guests must register in the office with vehicle information prior to going to your site.** All duration passes are charged accordingly in the office. **You must inform your guests of proper procedure for registration and parking.** Thank you. See #29 (CAR PASSES).
- **UTILITY TRAILERS NEED TO BE INSPECTED IN FRONT OF OFFICE BY MANAGEMENT BEFORE PROCEEDING.** Boats and utility trailers are not allowed to be parked on your site or an empty site. These should be parked across from office up to the grass line, not on the grass. **PLEASE NOTIFY US** when you are parking something there, so we know who to contact if something happens to it or it needs moving. See #19 (UTILITY TRAILERS).
- **SPEED LIMIT IS 5 MPH or 7 MPH IN SOME AREAS!!** Keep dust down and our campground safer for all our guests including children, pets, wildlife, bicyclists, joggers, and others.
- **GUESTS: Visiting hours are from 9am-7pm, daytime guests will need to vacate by 7pm.** Guests will need to re-register as an overnight guest before 7pm or inform at check-in. **No guests can arrive outside of visiting hours.** See #11 (GUESTS).
- **WE WILL NO LONGER USE THE HONEY WAGON FOR TRAILER PUMP-OUTS THAT ARE HARD TO CONNECT TO.** Valves must not leak and slide easily. Slide-Outs positioned over valves may need to be brought in to empty sewage. Emptying grey or black water tanks onto the ground is prohibited!
- **THE STATE REQUIREMENT THAT "Y"s ARE NO LONGER ALLOWED ON WATER FAUCETS HAS BEEN IN EFFECT SINCE LAST YEAR.** If you would like a second or third faucet added give us a call, so we can modify your site before the 2019 season opens. **DO NOT MAKE ANY MODIFICATIONS YOURSELF!**
- **DO NOT USE POISONS ON THE CAMPGROUND FOR WEEDS, GRASS, OR EVEN ANIMALS. A BABY DEER WAS POISONED IN THE PAST AND DIED FROM EATING SOMETHING POISONOUS.**
- **FIREWOOD IS NOT ALLOWED TO BE BROUGHT INTO THE CAMPGROUND.** Due to the Emerald Ash Borer insect, only wood from the campground will be allowed to be burned. This includes pallets, boards, 2 x's's, and wood of any kind, and if you have any of these left here please **take it off the campground this April!** We have approximately 80 Ash Trees.
- ***Proposed Seasonal Meeting Dates* Saturday @ NOON, on JUNE 1ST & AUGUST 31ST.** A meeting mid-season may occur depending on requests. (Dates are subject to change upon request & are weather permitting. Dates will be posted in the Office, on Facebook, our Website and in the Goose Poop.)
- **REQUIREMENTS: SEND IN ALL BY SUNDAY, MARCH 31ST OR A \$10.00 LATE FEE PER WEEK OR 1 ½% PER MONTH INTEREST, (WHICH-EVER IS GREATER), WILL BE APPLIED! There will also be a \$35.00 charge for returned check.**
